CREATIVE BRIFE

1. What must it be?

SUBJECT:

1. Why did you choose this location?

AMBIENT AUDIO:

1. What is the "location" of the piece? If we close our eyes, where should we imagine that we are?

Nature, gardening, and laughter would be the most ideal. I want the montage to feel like we are looking at lives we don't know but have had a great impact on the community we exist in. We don't tend notice these things unless we research ourselves.

PERMISSIONS:

1. Am I allowed to film here? Do I need permission and/or a permit?

There is no nothing on the site or the actual City of New Haven Parks that states otherwise, so I should be good. I would also be not using a lot of equipment, so obstruction isn't a concern. I will be careful of rentals though. Many people rent out parts of the park, and so if there is a major event going on, I will be respectful and not record.

2. Will any people be in my shots? Do I need permission and/or release forms?

Unlikely. However, if there is (since the park is public), or I wish for a shot, I will ask people if they would be okay within the shot.

GENERAL:

1. What gear do I need to pack and bring with me for the shoot? Film gear, sunscreen, water, etc.

I will be using the same equipment this week for the next week, which is the Canon T7 camera, a Tripod, and possibly a microphone. I will bring my iPhone as a just in case camera.

2. How will I transport everything and keep it safe?

Everything is in personal bags for their protection, so transportation isn't an issue.

3. Are there any potential hazards or complications at this location?

The only possible dangers of lighting and equipment issues. I learned this week that lighting is limited due to the winter months, so shots must be planned accordingly. I must also be careful as the equipment is owned by Quinnipiac.
